Career Integration Fellows Teaching Principles and Practices for Economics Course

The Teaching Principles and Practices for Economics Course includes 30 hours of seminars and workshops focusing on best practice related to teaching Economics in a university context. Topics covered in the seminars include effective teaching approaches to undergraduate students in the CEE region, use of internet and other computer-based resources, examination of ways professors can support academic integrity, and ongoing professional development through observation and evaluation.

The course introduces a range of effective approaches and methods to teaching Economics and provides opportunities for Teaching Fellows to apply these to their lessons through hands-on teaching practice. A core focus of the course is extensive feedback on practice lessons provided by pedagogical professionals, students, and peers, followed by structured opportunities for reflection.

The course is directly related to teaching in the field of Economics, and offers participants opportunities to strengthen their professional teaching skills and to expand their network of professional colleagues in the region, including establishing strong ties to CERGE-EI and its resources.
